

PREAMBLE

Asia is now home to almost 60% of the global population, and has several advantages in terms of strong academic innovation, close-knit economic ties, close time zones, large and growing markets, and vibrant industry and commerce.

Therefore, it makes sense to establish an Asian alliance for academia-industry partnerships that can work closely together to address unique Asian needs and challenges, and build upon these advantages to develop strong global competitiveness.

PRESENTING THE

A+A ASIA+ ALLIANCE FOR ACADEMIA-INDUSTRY PARTNERSHIP AND INNOVATION

Universities across the world today similarly face diverse challenges regarding intellectual property management, licensing, tech transfer, and academia-industry collaboration, yet there has not been an integrated effort to address these issues at an international level to date.

The A+A Asia+ Alliance for Academia-Industry Partnership and Innovation aims to serve as a platform at which experience, resources, and opportunities can be shared for the benefit of all, while maintaining the administrative independence of participating institutions.



THREE MAIN OBJECTIVES OF THE ALLIANCE

- 1. Pooling of licensable/transferable IP for international academia-industry collaboration
- 2. Organizing workshops, internships, and training for international talent cultivation
- 3. Leveraging third-party professional service providers to increase competitiveness



POOLING OF LICENSABLE/TRANSFERABLE IP FOR INTERNATIONAL ACADEMIA-INDUSTRY COLLABORATION

- -- Development of an online platform that integrates standardized information on licensable/transferable IP from participating universities
- -- Information can be scanned from existing databases or manually entered
- -- Platform can be used to develop IP collections for universities without such databases
- -- No proprietary information or databases need to be uploaded
- -- Platform can be searched by interested local and international businesses
- IP transfer and licensing will follow the existing procedures for each university



ORGANIZING WORKSHOPS, INTERNSHIPS, AND TRAINING FOR INTERNATIONAL TALENT CULTIVATION

- Opening of online or onsite access to participating universities for relevant events
- -- Organization of training and exchange workshops, symposiums, or internships pertaining to academia-industry collaboration
- Sharing of best practices and innovative initiatives
- -- Establishment of a community of Asian university tech transfer, licensing, and academia-industry collaboration managers to share experience and knowledge
- Annual onsite or online conference for the Alliance



LEVERAGING THIRD-PARTY PROFESSIONAL SERVICE PROVIDERS TO INCREASE COMPETITIVENESS

- -- Establish a database of reliable professional third-party providers to assist with IP, legal issues, finance issues, tech transfer/licensing, information management, and others
- -- Secure exclusive service packages or pricing for participating universities
- Organize regular tech transfer exchanges at different participating universities
- Organize joint academia-industry collaboration events at major global industry conferences and events outside Asia



PROPOSED STRUCTURE OF THE ALLIANCE

- Each participating university designates a key liaison officer as a contact window
- -- Two-year rotating secretary-general between different participating universities
- Organization of annual onsite or online conference for the Alliance
- -- Organize regular tech transfer exchanges at different participating universities
- Organize joint academia-industry collaboration events at major global industry conferences and events outside Asia
- -- IP platform can be built and maintained by National Taiwan University

OBLIGATIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF PARTICIPATING UNIVERSITIES

- Each participating university designates a key liaison officer as a contact window
- -- Participating universities share licensable/transferable IP on the Alliance platform
- -- Participating universities share events and workshops for talent cultivation
- -- Participating universities encourage collaborating enterprises to engage in local and international Alliance tech transfer/licensing or academia-industry collaboration events
- -- Participating universities share experience and best practices
- -- Participating universities cover the cost of own personnel when attending workshops or events hosted by other participating universities
- Existing administrative procedures regarding tech transfer/licensing at each participating university will not be affected in any way
